Thank you for your internet representation made on 17th February 2025 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

As with so many applications in Arundel, this is just another example of over development of the site. The owner's previous planning request of 1 No. dwelling over the first and second floors was, in my mind, perfectly reasonable, albeit 2 extra cars would have to be absorbed in an already heavily populated street with already serious lack of parking .

As if this new proposal for 3 No. dwellings weren't totally ridiculous anyway, how on earth does the applicant propose carrying out all the excavation works which now seems to be an integral part of his new 'big idea'.

Dig at night? I think not as it is a residential area.

Dig during the day and bring an already struggling small commercial community to it's knees?

I have already mentioned the serious lack of parking , so where does the client or indeed the council propose to park the new vehicles which will most likely number around 6 now?

As usual, no joined up thinking, no care for the neighbours' nor the community's inconvenience and no thought given to the appalling noise and air pollution.

We, who live in Arundel, remember well the terrible noise levels endured while the river was piled and the town's flood defences were strengthened. That however was for a good and necessary cause - the safety of Arundel residents , their homes and businesses. This proposal is to benefit one person in the whole community and benefiting that person to the serious detriment of everyone else.

Unlike flood defences, converting an existing property for the sole financial gain of the applicant only is not in the community's best interest.

It is for these numerous points that I object most heartily to this proposed development.
