Thank you for your internet representation made on 20th February 2025 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

I have been away and only gained sight of the application yesterday. I wish to add to my brief comments from yesterday.

This site has lain empty for over 5 years and I feel very strongly that any profit motive on the part of the owner of the building who I believe may no longer live in the town must not under any circumstances be allowed to take precedence over the interests of residents, businesses and visitors.

It is hard to see how this development is of any benefit to Arundel and should be rejected on multiple grounds.

I cannot see any cultural or heritage benefit for the town from this development and it can only result in a negative impact on this conservation area. I cannot see how the development would not violate conservation protection policies right in the centre of this historic town.

The traffic disruption during the development would be unimaginable. Tarrant Street is a busy road and the impact on residents (who struggle to find parking at the best of times), businesses, visitors and on deliveries and not forgetting access for emergency services during development would be truly appalling. Scaffolding, blocked roads, loss of parking spaces, noise, delays would all be totally unacceptable. Parking is already a nightmare for many people along Tarrant Street so bringing in a further 6-8 potential requirement for parking spaces when the development is also completely ludicrous.

This application must be refused
