I strongly object to this application. Our family home since 2002 is in Norton Lane, a narrow country lane with no street lighting or pavements. I believe this proposed development would not only damage the Norton Lane Conservation Area aspect, but also, the resulting extra commercial traffic would compromise safety, particularly in the dark winter months. Having another functional business with commuter and delivery vehicles coming and going would negatively affect the tranquil nature of Norton Lane.

My sister, mother and friends keep horses in the lane. The resulting extra commercial traffic would hinder the ability to ride and move horses as safely and compromise the safety and enjoyment of residents, walkers and dog walkers using the lane.

Thank you for your consideration in favour of the residents who would be adversely impacted.
