We take our lives in our hands when trying to exit Meadow Way. Our road is used twice and day, sometimes 3 times a day by the parents of children in our local infant and junior school.

Our field has much wild life that live there. The field also floods badly in the winter months and our ditches fill up quite quickly. I take it the council will be responsible for this if the field is built on? All the building will push the water to the ditches which will be too much for us to manage.

The sewage system here is overloaded and often needs to be pumped out.  
We do not have enough dentists and doctors, let alone school places.
