To whom it may concern,

I am writing to object the building of 89 residential dwellings for the following reasons:

1. The height of the flats is taller than any other property in the area and cuts everyone's right to light. We have a dark skies policy in place. No other development in the area includes flats. The properties down Meadow Way are predominantly bungalows and is a quiet cul-de-sac which wouldn't cope with an extra 180 cars daily. The surrounding roads are often gridlocked and badly corroded.
2. There are already long waiting lists for nhs appointments. The local primary and secondary schools are full. There are no nhs dentist in the area. The existing foul sewage system cannot cope already and often overflows. It is at capacity.
3. There is a huge problem with flooding in the very area you are planning to build. I've seen flows of water rush from the alley onto Meadow Way and the alleyway opposite has been impassable due to floods.
4. Most importantly, the area is home to a wealth of local wildlife. Where will they go if their home is turned into bricks? Foxes, owls, mice, moles, voles, birds of prey, badgers, insects to name but a few, all currently live on this site.
