I'm seriously concerned with the planning of the housing application (AL/137/24/RES)

I have lived in Lamorna Gardens for nearly 8years and The exit via Meadow way is dangerous enough as it is to get in and out due to the blind bend even with the number of houses already existing in meadow way/the fields/Lamorna gardens let alone adding at least 180 cars, this will definitely cause a death due to the blind bend and extra flow of traffic you are planning with this housing estate.

And cause double the amount of traffic/grid lock, especially in rush hours.

The flooding which affects Hook lane regularly will flow the traffic even more on the meadow way entrance and exit.
