I wish to object once again to this application.

The flats proposed are completely out of character for the area. What transport links would attract anyone to purchase property in this location.

The proposed access to this development involving the demolition of a property on a bend in addition to access onto the main A29 is dangerous.

The flooding in Meadow Way has already become worse with recent developments, consideration must be given as further development will not improve this and impact existing properties.

I am unimpressed that the current developer has already erected large signage advertising the development. I'm unsure for whose benefit apart from alienating residents as it is only residents that pass the sign.

Finally also distressed that utility works involving digging trenches in Meadow Way are commencing 3rd March prior to a decision being made on this application.
