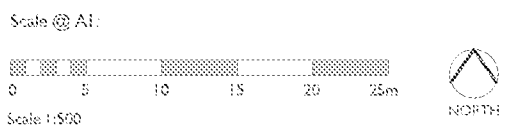

 - Rubber mulch play surface in brown and green
 - Slabs to garden path Laid in stack bond
 - Self-binding gravel
