We have winter groundwater monitoring already completed and our drainage consultant is working up a detailed scheme to address the issues raised by the LLFA, we will send over once ready.

In the meantime we have now had the River condition assessment completed along with the water vole surveys and the BNG calculations prepared. I am attaching these. You will note that there is a deficit of 0.07 watercourse units which we will need to purchase credits for. Subject to your positive recommendation we would look to secure these from a registered provider but you will appreciate that given the cost we would like to know that the principle of development is acceptable before we commit to this.


