### Legal Description

Multi-Period site including Prehistoric and Mesolithic flint working and possible occupation, Neolithic pottery, a Beaker settlement dating to the Early Bronze Age, a Middle Bronze Age cremation urn with possibly associated burnt mounds of the same date, a Bronze Age field system with occupation evidence and cremations, and further settlement sites dating to the later Bronze Age, Iron Age and Roman periods, including an Iron Age Warrior grave and a Roman field system, and evidence for a Medieval Park and medieval pottery. There are World War Two features within the area including pill boxes, the site of a gun emplacement and a tank trap.
