EH Comments:

I have received the submitted application, and I am concerned about the impact this proposed change of use may have. Residential care homes for children can result in children with extra sensory needs being placed in a semi-detached property that is not designed for this purpose, such as this proposed property.

I am concerned that the insulation in the house is not satisfactory to protect the neighbours from the noise this use will produce, therefore I would recommend the following condition should consent be granted.

Conditions Recommended:

PCEHN13 : Sound insulation - conflicting room uses

The change of use hereby permitted shall not begin until full details of an enhanced sound insulation scheme shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The scheme shall achieve a minimum of 5dB better than the maximum Building Regulations value for the floor/ceiling/walls separating different types of rooms in adjoining dwellings (e.g. kitchen above a bedroom). The scheme shall be retained and maintained in perpetuity.

The applicant should review the Planning Noise Advice Document – Sussex,


