Description of works: Erection of 1 No. two storey dwelling (self build) (resubmission following CM/15/24/PL). This application affects the setting of listed buildings, is a Departure from the Development Plan and is in CIL Zone 5 and is CIL Liable as a new dwelling.

Thank you for your internet representation made on 11th March 2025 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

The National Trust has noted the above planning application and I am writing to correct an error in the Planning Statement and Heritage Statement for the application. Both state that the application is not covered by the covenants that the Trust holds over land at Climping Beach. That is incorrect. The land is subject to restrictive covenants, including:

"No new building or other erection shall without the previous written consent of the Trust at any time be erected or allowed to remain upon any part of the said land"

Formal consent under the terms of the covenant is required before any works can commence. At this stage, the applicants have not approached the National Trust to discuss this matter and the proposed works do not have consent from the National Trust. Whilst we acknowledge that matters under covenant are entirely separate from the statutory planning system and covenants are not a material consideration under planning, we would like to reiterate that no works can commence without the Trust's formal consent.

Until the National Trust has had the chance to consider this application, I cannot offer any assurances that covenant consent would be forthcoming

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
