Thank you for your internet representation made on 15th October 2025 which has been recorded as no objection with the comments as follows:

This council's Planning & Licensing Committee considered this application at its meeting on Monday, 13th October.

Although the committee agreed unanimously to raise no objections to this application, it did ask me to make the following comment and request.

The comment: the committee was unable to find any application which explicitly applied to the construction of the garage building, although I found several applications from 1978-1980 which mention garages being built in Meadow Park, but the specifics are understandably not online.

The request: if ADC is minded to grant Planning Permission, please could it include a Condition to ensure the converted garage is only ever used as ancillary to the main dwelling.
