Ferring Parish Council objects to this application on environmental and drainage grounds.

There is already a significant issue with flooding at this location, additional building will just exacerbate the flooding issues.

Within the application there does not appear to be any consideration to address this drainage/flooding issues.

It is noted that the Arboriculture Survey recommends excavation under supervision to prevent root damage.

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
