Description of works: Erection of 1 No 1-bedroom self build house with associated parking & private outdoor amenity space. This application is in CIL Zone 4 and is CIL Liable as a new dwelling.

Thank you for your internet representation made on 25th January 2026 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

OWPC81059

I object yet again to the revised/tweaked plans for this proposed one bed property, on this tiny parcel of land. The property would still have to be shoehorned in and would be a total overdevelopment of this site, which was originally part of the garden of 30 Brook Lane. Sinking the property into the ground by 60cms is not a solution and doesn't take away that this build would be too big and overbearing for the plot. It would invade on the privacy of its neighbours, being built too close to their boundaries and is totally out of character with the existing surrounding bungalows. The proposed parking (which shows x 2 tandem spaces on the plans but only documents one parking space in the covering letter), is insufficient for the size of todays vehicles and there is no room in The Grove for on street parking.

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
