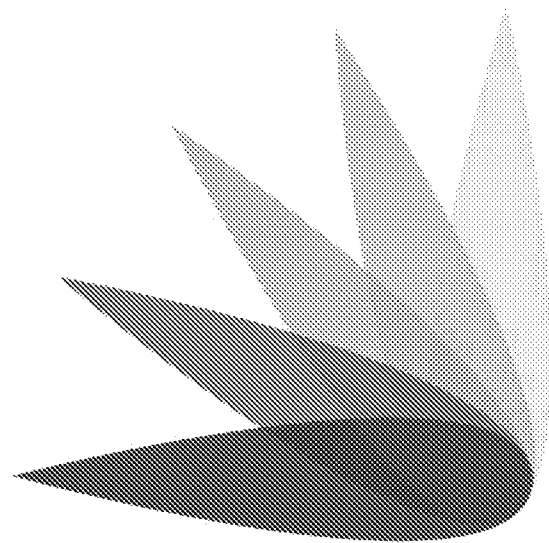

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1 Reeves Transport Planning is appointed to provide a Transport Report in support of a planning application at Kivesborough, Littlehampton Road, Ferring. A site location plan is attached, as Appendix 1.
- 1.2 The proposal seeks to provide three residential dwellings within the grounds of Kivesborough. Appropriate parking and turning is included that will be accessed via the existing vehicle access route that serves Kivesborough and an adjacent dwelling.
- 1.3 This Transport Report is drafted with reference to West Sussex County Council's guidance on the content of Transport Assessments and Government guidance on Travel Plans, Transport Assessments and Statements, published March 2014.
- 1.4 It will present the proposal's limited transport impact and confirm that the proposed dwellings can be safely accessed.

## 2. Policy Context

- 2.1 This section of the Transport Report sets out the relevant policies, at a national and local level, that this proposal will be judged against.
- 2.2 The **National Planning Policy Framework**, most recently updated September 2023, sets out the Government's planning policy and is a material consideration in planning decisions. Its emphasis is on minimising the need to travel, reducing car use, and encouraging the use of sustainable transport. Paragraph 110 states that in assessing development sites it should be '*ensured that:*
  - *appropriate opportunities to promote sustainable transport modes can be – or have been - taken up, given the type of development and its location;*
  - *safe and suitable access to the site can be achieved for all users;*
  - *the design of streets, parking areas, other transport elements and the content of associated standards reflects current national guidance, including the National Design Guide and the National Model Design Code 46; and*

- ❖ *any significant impacts from the development on the transport network (in terms of capacity and congestion), or on highway safety, can be cost effectively mitigated to an acceptable degree.'*

2.3 At the NPPF is a presumption in favour of sustainable development, and decision makers, at all levels, are encouraged to seek approval where possible. Paragraph 111 emphasises this and states that *'development should only be prevented or refused on highway grounds if there would be an **unacceptable** impact on highway safety, or the residual cumulative impacts on the road network would be **severe**'.*

2.4 Development will be required to support the objectives of the **West Sussex Transport Plan 2022-2036**. It contains five thematic and eight area transport strategies that are intended to deliver the plan's objectives.

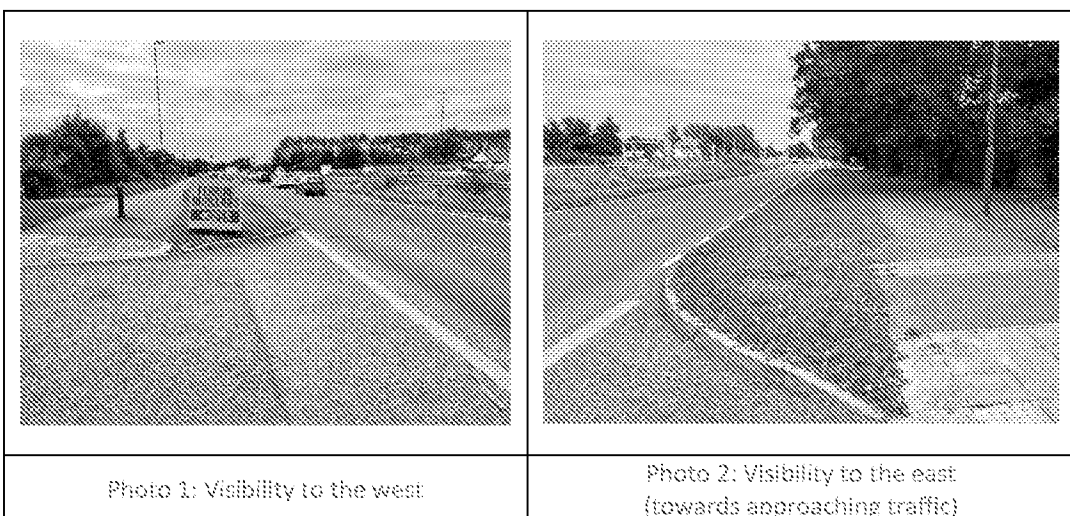
2.5 The **Arun Local Plan 2011-2031**, adopted July 2018, provides clarity on transport and development within the district and its role in ensuring that growth strengthens Arun's economic base, reduces congestion, works to tackle climate change, and promotes healthy lifestyles. **Policy T SP1** states that the council will certify that development:

- ❖ Provides safe impact onto the highway network.
- ❖ Contributes to highway improvements.
- ❖ Promotes sustainable transport (including low emission fuels); and
- ❖ Encourages transport improvements to public transport infrastructure as well as the cycle, pedestrian, and bridleway network.

2.6 This Transport Report will demonstrate that the transport implications of the proposal meet the requirements of both local and national policies, and that it will not have any adverse impact on highway safety or capacity.

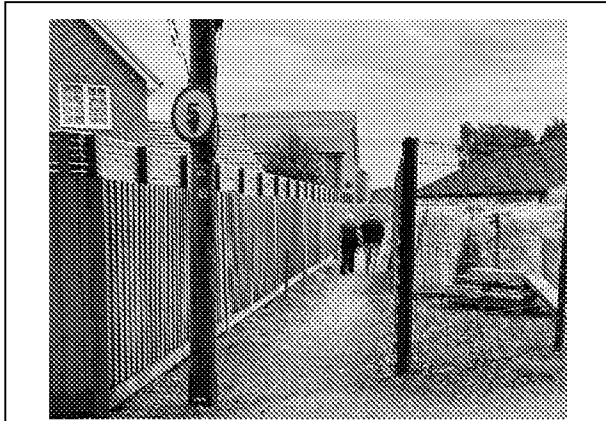
### 3. Existing Conditions

- 3.1 The site includes an existing residential dwelling, Kivesborough, and two areas of green space, to the north and south, with a hard standing gravel drive that provides access to Kivesborough and another dwelling on the southern elevation.
- 3.2 The site is located between the residential and commercial area of Ferring, with Asda and Ferring Nurseries just to the west. The eastern boundary borders dwellings on Hermione Close, to the north there is a public footpath and an adjacent dwelling to the south.
- 3.3 Kivesborough is located circa two kilometres north of Ferring beach, circa seven kilometres west of central Worthing and just south of Littlehampton Road (A259).
- 3.4 The A259, Littlehampton By-Pass, provides a direct connection to Bognor Regis, to the west, and Worthing to the east. It also links to the A24 and A27, which heads east to Brighton and west to Chichester. There is a 3 metres wide cycle and pedestrian route and 3.5 metres wide verge on the southern side of the A259, crossing the access to the site.
- 3.5 This section of the A259 is a dual carriageway, with vehicular access from the east and egress from the west. The photographs below highlight the ample visibility in both directions from the access.



3.6 The site is accessed from Littlehampton Road via the existing junction serving Ferring Nurseries, through the Nurseries car park and service area.

3.7 The Public Right Of Way (PROW) 2125 on the site's northern boundary connects Langbury Lane to Littlehampton Road, via the access to Ferring Nurseries car park. There is a small informal gap in the tree line on the western side of the access road that provides a shorter route to the nearby food store. An extract of the West Sussex County Council's PROW online mapping

indicating the route of PROW 2125 is attached at Appendix 2 and a photograph is opposite.

#### *Accessibility by Foot and Cycle*

3.8 It is generally accepted that walking and cycling provide realistic and important alternatives to the private car. Walking and cycling are also actively encouraged to form part of longer journeys that involve public transport. The distances people are prepared to walk, or cycle depend on their fitness and physical ability, journey purpose, settlement size, and walking/cycling conditions. The mean average length for walking journeys is circa one kilometre and for cycling, it is four kilometres, although journeys of up to three times these distances are not uncommon for regular commuters (LTN 1/04 - Policy, Planning and Design for Walking and Cycling).

3.9 Ferring Nurseries is adjacent to Kivesborough and Asda Superstore, and its petrol station, is a circa 250metre walk. There are several schools within a reasonable walk and Northbrook College is a circa 28minute walk.

#### *Accessibility by Bus*

3.10 The nearest stops are a circa 200metre walk to Littlehampton Road (A259), which is well within the recommended walking distance to bus stops. These stops service

the regular 700 Coastliner route to Brighton is available on Courtwick Road, which is a circa 420metre walk.

- 3.11 Table 3.1 presents a summary of the routes available and their frequencies, and the timetables are attached at Appendix 3.

#### Accessibility by Train

- 3.12 Goring by Sea Rail Station is situated circa two kilometres from Kivesborough, which is a circa 26minute walk and 12minute cycle via Langbury Lane. The station is served by Southern Railways that provide frequent journeys to Gatwick, London Victoria, Brighton, and Portsmouth. A Southern Railways network map is attached at Appendix 4.
- 3.13 In summary, the proposal site has a good level of local amenities with accessibility to sustainable and public transport modes, as there are bus stops and a rail station within a reasonable walking and cycling distance.

## 4. Proposed Development

- 4.1 The proposal seeks to introduce three three-bedroom dwellings to land within the residential curtilage of Kivesborough, Littlehampton Road.
- 4.2 A total of six car parking spaces are proposed, with appropriate levels of cycle parking introduced within the garages. There is ample turning space retained within the site.

4.3 Tracking for a fire appliance is attached at Appendix 5. The bin storage areas for both existing dwellings is located at the western end of the access track.

This same area will be employed for the refuse storage of the new dwellings. This avoids the need for a refuse vehicle to manoeuvre into and out of the site. A photograph of the bin storage area is shown opposite.

For completeness the tracking of a refuse vehicle ingress, turning and egress is also included with Appendix 5.

4.4 The dwellings will be accessed via the route that serves the two existing houses through Ferring Nurseries.

## 5. Transport and Traffic Impact

### Trip Generation

5.1 The latest version of the TRICS database (7.10.3) has been used to estimate the additional vehicular movements generated by the proposed development.

Sites included are under land use 03 Residential A Houses Privately Owned within south east England, excluding Greater London and without a Travel Plan. The full TRICS output is included, as Appendix 6.

5.2 The TRICS data indicates that, the proposed three residential dwellings, will generate circa 2 vehicle movements in the AM peak and 2 vehicle movements during the PM peak.

5.3 Overall, it is evident that the proposed residential dwellings will not represent any adverse impact on the proposed access or surrounding road network when taking into consideration the likely traffic impact associated with Ferring Nurseries .

## 6. Parking Demand and Provision

- 6.1 Arun District Council's Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document, published in January 2020 sets out the district's requirements of parking provision at development.
- 6.2 The guidance informs that a total of two car parking spaces per dwelling, with one secure and covered cycle parking space should be provided.
- 6.3 A total of six car parking spaces are provided and a minimum of three cycle parking spaces are included in the garages serving each dwelling, which complies with the local adopted guidance.

## 7. Summary and Conclusions

- 7.1 Reeves Transport Planning is appointed to provide a Transport Report in support of an application to introduce three dwellings to land within the residential curtilage of Kivesborough, Littlehampton Road.
- 7.2 The proposal site is located between the residential and commercial area of Ferring, with Asda and Ferring Nurseries just to the west. Kivesborough is located circa two kilometres north of Ferring beach, circa seven kilometres west of central Worthing and just south of Littlehampton Road (A259). The A259 provides a direct connection to Bognor Regis, to the west, and Worthing to the east. It also links to the A24 and A27, which heads east to Brighton and west to Chichester.
- 7.3 The site has a good level of local amenities with accessibility to sustainable and public transport modes, as there are bus stops and a rail station providing regular services within a reasonable walking distance.
- 7.4 The proposed development includes appropriate levels of on-plot parking provision and an improved access arrangement that meets the District Council's adopted standards.
- 7.5 TRICS analysis confirms that the proposal is likely to generate circa 15 vehicle movements per day. This equates to a minimal traffic impact during the AM peak

hour of less than one vehicle movement every 30 minutes. This level of traffic is not considered to represent an adverse impact on the proposed access or surrounding road network.

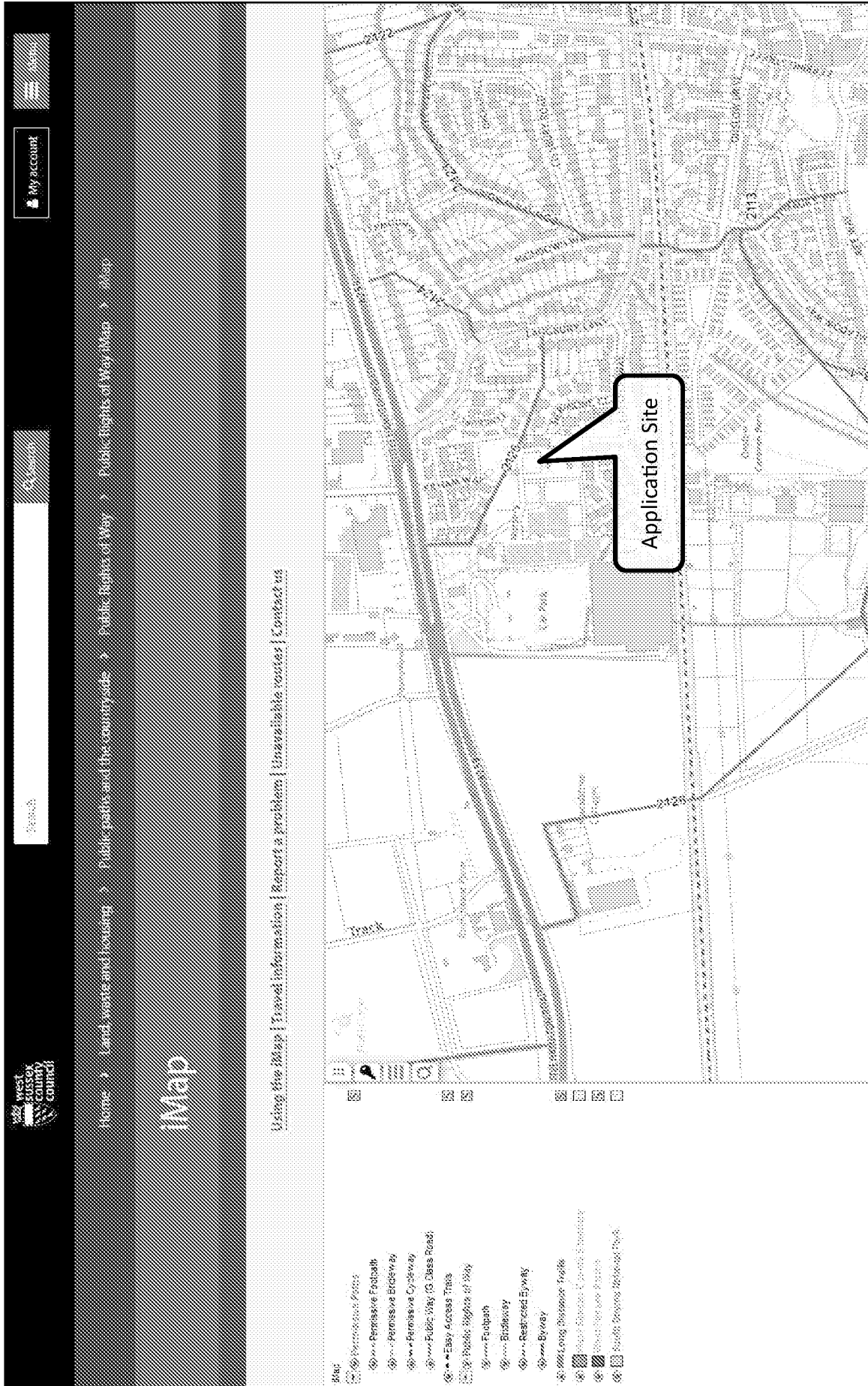
- 7.6 Therefore, taking all the relevant information into consideration including the likely limited increase in daily traffic movements, the accessibility of the site and good links to all modes of travel, it is evident that the proposed development will not have a **severe** impact on highway capacity or an **unacceptable** impact on highway safety. Therefore, this proposal will fully comply with the relevant national and local policies and adopted guidance.
