We have signage with the company name and logo including the house name. We would like to illuminate this sign at night from approx. 16:30 in winter until 22:00. These times would be less in the lighter summer months, so perhaps only lit for an hour or two from 20:00-22:00.

An illuminated sign will also assist emergency services in locating the property in the dark.

The sign is a plastic box with a soft white light inside which is lit with 6500K cool white LEDs installed for face illumination, complete with a 60w outdoor-rated power supply.
