Description of works: Installation of 1 No. internally illuminated sign. (Retrospective).

Thank you for your internet representation made on 27th February 2025 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

OWPC74592

While this retrospective application is for the internal illumination of the signage, the overall impact of the sign and its location is pertinent.

The sign is located opposite the war memorial and at the entrance to the conservation area. Its size, height and colour are an unnecessarily commercially dominant feature unsuited to that position. The internal LED lighting is overly bright, serves no practical purpose and totally unnecessary as it is positioned close to a street lamp.

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
