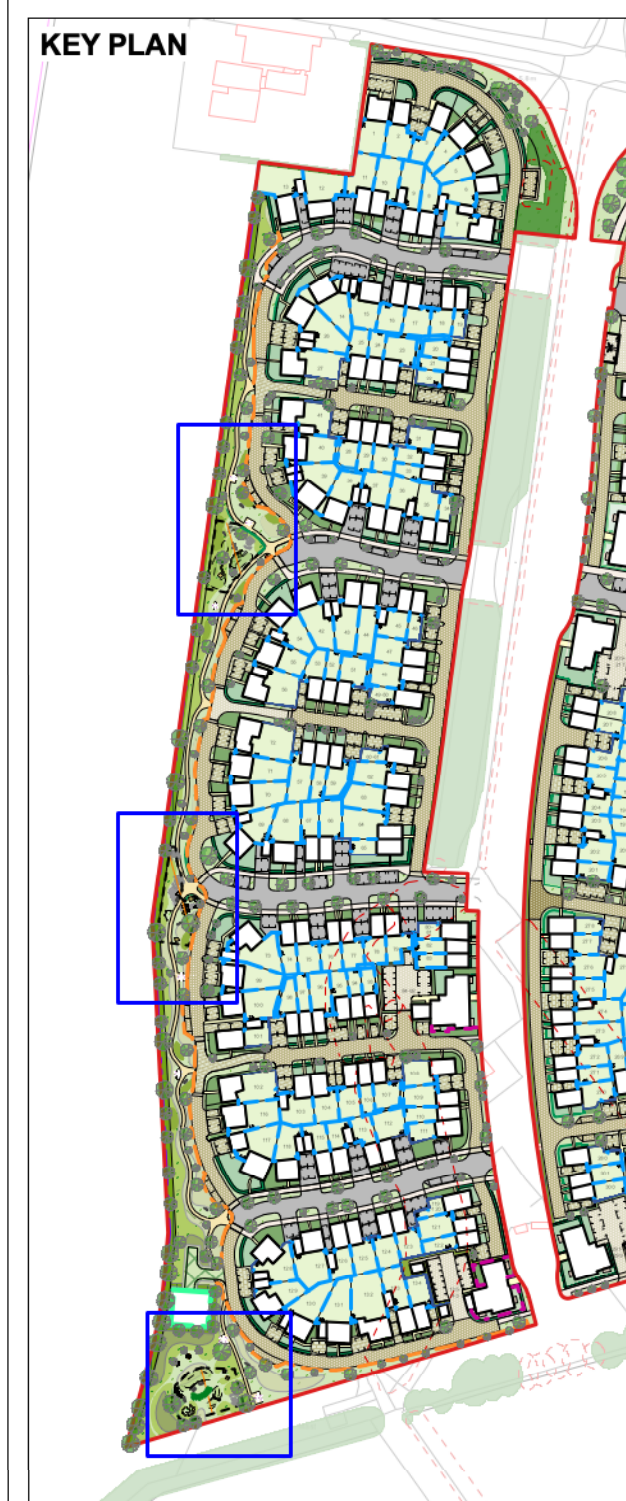
- Interactive panels (role play and imagination)

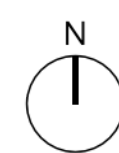
