Thank you for your internet representation made on 17th October 2024 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

I have some areas of concern.

-Ryebank Park name is also confusing as there is a Ryebank Gate development in Yapton.
- Footpath 175 through RM4 appears to have been made a road. Perhaps with cycleway? This is unfortunate for leisure walkers but perhaps could be mitigated by a permissive footpath through the Ryebank Park area. Is the same likely to happen in the area RM5 where FP175 starts?

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
