I wish to strongly object to the construction of these 4 living units with staff accomodation,I do not think any thought has been put into this planning application for the second time.

If built,you will have constant noise from passenger trains from 04-30am until 01-00am,also empty rolling stock going to Littlehampton to be cleaned at night with there train washing machine and freight trains also durind nights.

Our property's shake now with vibration of trains traveling over the points and crossing and rail joints,where you are going to construct these new living units.

These new units will be overlooking and become intrusive to some of the residential properties of our site.

Are all the trees going too be removed from the railway embankment,where the living units are going to be built,if so,this is going to create even more noise from trains passing each way.

There will be more road traffic congestion outside ford house on ford road,where these new proposed living units and your property are located now.

It is bad enough now trying to get in and out of our properties,sometimes you get stuck at these railway barriers between 10 and 18 minutes,which is causing severe traffic jams each way on Ford road,it is even worse now that Network Rail have introduced new timetables with more extra trains,up to 20 trains an hour plus freight traffic as well.

Then we will have to endure all the construction noise,from all types of machinery with dust flying through the air,on to our property's.

There are a lot of people on our site with health issues, myself included and those that are house-bound and moved here for peace and quite, for which they advised to try and sleep during the day. We accept that a few patients are sometimes a bit noisy, but this is not their fault, but due to their illness.

This is my objection to the above application.
