


PROPOSED ELEVATIONS




PROPOSED REAR ELEVATION 1:100
(facing south)

PROPOSED EXTERNAL ALTERATIONS TO TUMBLEY:

- Where shown, the existing thatched roof is to be replaced with plain clay orange/red, handmade tiles with mitred valleys and bonnet tile for the ridges and plain unbonnet hip tiles. Where thatch is shown on elevations and plans, the thatch is to be replaced.
- Composite dark grey fascia and soffit boards and powder coated aluminium rainwater goods (colour to match windows). Eyebrow details in tiles will not have gutters; the rafter feet are to be exposed and painted to match windows.
- Existing windows to be replaced with new double glazed windows with a dark cream frame.
- Part of the existing single-storey rear projection to have the thatched roof replaced with a balcony with glass balustrade and timber handrail. Thatch will remain and be replaced at each end, nearest neighbouring houses to maintain the neighbours privacy.
- Ground Floor brickwork with inset render panels to be rendered and painted a light cream colour.
- Existing Mock Tudor 1st floor timber feather edged paneling to be replaced with straight edge timber paneling, painted a dark cream to match new windows.
- New enlarged garage door fitted within the existing masonry wall where the original garage door has been blocked up.
