Thank you for consulting the Environment Agency on the above application.

We have reviewed the information as submitted and set out our position below.

#### **Environment Agency Position**

We have **no objection** to the proposed development as submitted.

The proposed development will reduce the overall risk to occupants of the property by reducing the number of residential units and providing safe refuge. This application provides a clear betterment on the existing permitted use.

We strongly recommend that the most vulnerable uses, such as sleeping accommodation, be restricted to the upper floors to reduce the risk to future occupants.


