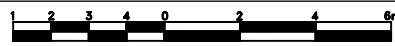

- 1.2m Metal Estate Railings
- 1.2m Post & Rail Fence with Mesh to lower section
- 0.6m Black Steel Knee Rail
- 2.0m High V-Mesh Fencing with matching double maintenance gate at road entrance
