

Economic Development has reviewed the documentation relating to the proposed retail phase of this development. We welcome the additional jobs and potential entrepreneurial opportunities that could arise from small pop-up units. We note that there are a number of significant assumptions regarding the redevelopment of the former Body Shop site, which may influence the potential occupancy of the Hampton Park site.

That said, we agree that the proposed retail mix is appropriate to serve this development and should primarily focus on ‘top-up’ retail for local residents rather than anything more substantial. On this basis, we do not believe the scheme would have a sufficiently detrimental impact on either the Wick shopping area or Littlehampton town centre to warrant any objection from us.
