I truly feel that a new retail park will be of immense benefit to the town. It will mean an otherwise wasted space being utilised for the benefit of everyone in the immediate area and beyond. With free parking and an increase in job opportunities it will benefit local people. A bus service to the park would increase the footfall for those using public transport. Avoiding going towards Bognor would also be helpful as the A259 often has traffic congestion between Littlehampton and Bognor. I would definitely visit the retail park if it has a good mix of shops, eateries and leisure activities and I am 100% in favour of the development, I hope the plan is put into action swiftly
