Application for Planning Permission for Works or Extension to a Dwelling

Development: To clad the top half of all walls of the house with either UPVC or Cedral Fibre Cement Weatherboarding to include new Fascias and Soffits.
Colour to be decided, depending on restriction, but a very pale green or cream preferred.
My house is situated on the A27, on the border between Arundel and Lyminster and Crossbush and is just on the Lyminster side close to Arundel Station and by the Pelican Crossing near the Causeway Roundabout. The ditch running parallel to my garden is the Parish Boundary between Arundel and Lyminster. The house faces the A27. My house at the moment is fully rendered with K Rend in Cream. The render is very stained and the staining continues to return, even after cleaning. In order to combat this my proposal is to clad the top half of all the walls of the house with Fibre Cement Weatherboarding and to fit new Fascias and Soffits. The Colour of the cladding is to be decided, depending on any restrictions, but a very pale green or cream is preferred. Not only will the cladding cover over the stained render on the top half of the house, but I believe that it will enhance the appearance of the house too. The remaining render on the bottom half of the house walls will be easily accessed for cleaning and redecoration.
