Dear Planning Officer

I wish to make comments and a request in respect of the above planning application.

I live in 7 Elmer Close the property immediately adjacent to the rear of the property making the above planning application(9 Alleyne Way).

Given that proximity and potential impact of the proposed building works I was disappointed to note that I had not been approached directly or served with copy of planning application in question. When the current development was subjected to the original planning application I was approached and visited by the Planning Officer because of direct impact. The same applies now hence my disappointment over recently discovering by chance the existence of Planning Application M/83/25/HH affixed to the Estate's Notice board at The Hard nearly a hundred metres away from my residence?

My only comment and request about the plans is that the Planning Authority requires the use of "Opaque" glass in the window of the rear of the proposed first floor of the extension. This would be the same as the condition imposed on the original development by requiring all first floor windows to be fitted with opaque glass to prevent overlooking.
