

I refer to the above Application, which proposes the installation of an externally mounted ASHP on the south elevation of the building facing the upper beach, which is designated as part of Pagham Harbour SSSI. I agree with the Environmental Health Officer's comments that the proposed heap pump is likely to be un-neighbourly and intrusive to the adjoining property, 107 West Front Road, and believe that the heap pump should be re-sited.

From personal experience I consider fixing the HP to an external elevation of the subject property, would also be intrusive to the residents of 109 and this current proposal should certainly be re-considered.
