Description of works: Outline application with some matters reserved, except access, for up to 120 No residential dwellings including means of access into the site (not internal roads). This application is a Departure from the Development and affects a Public Right of Way.

Thank you for your internet representation made on 23rd April 2026 which has been recorded as an objection with the comments as follows:

OWPC83069

1. Summer Lane and its footpaths are narrow and the exit and entry to Summer Lane into Pagham Road is not sufficient to see both sides of the highway. This enforces drivers to pull out beyond the road markings which is dangerous and the extra flow of traffic will exacerbate the situation.
2. We understand that new build developments are built on higher ground and foundations to the surrounding buildings and infrastructure to prevent flooding. If this is the case then the near by Summer Lane development and Mill Farm development will be subject to flooding.
3. The plan of a junction to cross over into the proposed development with a restriction to turn left or right further down Summer Lane will be subject to abuse and accidents as is the case on a development in Westvale Road in Horley. This development has had several crashes already.
4. Current highways in and out of Pagham will not be able to accommodate the extra traffic as recent surveys show that households have on average over two cars per dwelling. Extra houses lead to extra cars. There is already an unacceptable flow of traffic at certain times of the day leading to several of the A27 exits and even more traffic will cause pollution.risk of flooding

Your views as made above will be considered before the application is determined.
