WSSC as the County Highways Authority raise no objection to the proposal to create 5 garages to the rear of no 43 Old Manor Road.

The garages are located at the end of an existing garage compound which is accessed from Campbell Drive. The access here provides good visibility onto the highway. Plans submitted show the garages can be accessed with ease for entry and exit to be able to leave the compound in forward gear.

During the building of the garages, it is important that access is not blocked for existing garages on site, however as the site is not within the public highway boundary, as such it will be up to the applicant to ensure any building materials are kept in a location which does not impact on the existing use.
