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Dear Rhiannon

I have received correspondence from Rustington Parish Council relating to the above-mentioned application for a Lawful Development Certificate, and I note their request to process this application via the formal planning application procedure.

Whilst I appreciate there is no statutory consultation for an LDC, would it be possible for the Council to consider following in this matter:

- The provision of screening (soft or hard landscaping), within the boundaries of the applicants' property, to reduce the impact of the mobile home due its mass and proximity to adjoining boundaries.
- External lighting to be limited to safeguard against light pollution and visual impact to adjoining properties that may overlook the mobile home.
