Dear Mrs Baly,

I have made up a tree application with reference AW/14/25/TC and have sent an email requesting additional information. The tree validation requirements document attached gives more detailed wording and hyperlinks. You need to refer to 'Works to a tree in a conservation area', page 4 onwards.

You need to provide a plan that clearly shows the location of the tree/s. Where the application involves more than 1 tree the trees should be clearly labelled. The plan should include at least one road name and any adjoining properties, so the location is very clear. A north point is also helpful.

Please also clarify the height and spread of the trees, in metres, **after** the proposed crown reduction. An application form is not needed as we have received an email request from yourself.

You will receive a letter when the case has been decided from where works can then be carried out. You need to wait for approval.
