The dwellinghouses would use the existing vehicular access from Barnham Lane which has good visibility at the junction with the road. The proposed residential use of the site would be likely to reduce the number of vehicular movements in comparison to the agricultural use of the site.

The proposed change of use of the buildings from agricultural to residential use would not cause any significant increase in vehicular traffic that would be harmful to the operation of the highway network.

There would be no concerns regarding the noise impacts from the development as all the former agricultural buildings would be converted to residential dwellings or removed from the site.
